Interview, Offense History,

**SCREEN for Urgent/
Safety issues (suicidality,
assaultiveness, active
gang rivalry, etc.)**

**Refer out if
problematic,
(hospital, secure
facility, etc.)**

Mental Health Issues Assessment:

- Depression, anxiety, anger
- * Trauma, abuse issues
 - history of physical or sexual abuse, rape, severe neglect, prostitution, teen pregnancy, removal from family; parent who is deceased, absent, incarcerated, or abusing drugs
- * Grief
- * Violent or impulsive behavior
- * Self-destructive or Self-defeating acting out.
 - suicidal thoughts, self-mutilation, eating disorder
- Substance / drug abuse
- Sex offender issues
- Gang involvement
- Psychotropic medication needs, prior mental health treatment programs

**Initial Educational
Assessment:**

- Need for IEP, Special Education
- ADD / ADHD issues
- Developmental delays or learning disabilities
- Vocational aptitudes and skills, work opportunities
- Recommendations/ consultation with teachers, school
